The two play sessions take place between 3pm & 5pm on Tuesdays and from 10am to 12 midday on Fridays

Please supervise your children when eating to make sure they don't leave food lying around and please clean up any spillages or leftovers.

If your child has a toileting accident, we ask you to clean up. We will provide gloves and cleaning materials. Please have a spare set of clothes with you.
