Furthermore, most of our learners also present with special educational needs including autism (ASC/ASD), PDS, ADD/ADHD, SEMH, dyslexia and trauma. All our lessons are bespoke to each learner and taught by highly experienced, specialist practitioners. Teaching sessions take place during the school day and/or in the evenings and at weekends. Most lessons are taught in person at the family home, but they can also be facilitated online.

Tutoring sessions vary in length from 1.5 hours/week up to a maximum of 15 hours/week. They can be facilitated on a short term basis for a fixed number of weeks, or placements can be longer term.
